**Shell Lake** is located approximately 1 ½ hours northeast of the Twins Cities. The City of Shell Lake is on the western shores. Bosch-Doboy graciously allows regatta participants the use of their private shoreline; there is more than enough space for boat set up on the grassy beach.

**Camping:** **Shell Lake Municipal Campground:** featuring lakeshore camping, one block from downtown Shell Lake. Reservations required (It maybe too late already) contact the campground directly at (715) 468-7846.

**Red Barn:** A quiet country setting (old farm), one mile east of the regatta site on County Rd B. We have a group reservation but please call ahead if possible to ensure we have enough space, just mention the regatta and they will direct you the proper area. (715) 468-2575

**Racing:** The Broken Rudder regatta has the tradition of being the annual Minnesota vs Wisconsin border battle, Gopher vs Badger. Straight Portsmouth handicap scoring, one start, no individual throw-outs. Individual scores are combined for the team score, with throw-outs allowed for the team with the most boats. The winning team takes the prize, the Broken Rudder.

Now in our eleventh year of this popular event, we are sending out a special invitation to our friends from Iowa, Michigan and Illinois to join in the fun and see if they have what it takes to take home the Rudder. Team scores will be handicapped based on team size to give everyone a fair chance of winning.

Registration includes a \$5/boat fee we must pay the City of Shell Lake for our invasive species boat inspections. Also includes Saturday night dinner for all competitors plus light snacks to help you through the day on Saturday.
